



**BOOK REVIEW:**  
**THE UNMISTAKABLE TOUCH OF GRACE**  
Cheryl Richardson

I think this is the first book in the spiritual genre that I have read from cover to cover in a few days and actually wanted to read again. It follows Cheryl Richardson's experiences of grace, what she defines as the 'power force that leads you in the right direction'. Cheryl recounts experiences from her own life and clients and friends inspirational stories to demonstrate how grace works. At the end of each chapter she has an experiment for the reader to try e.g. Starting a grace journal or joining a group. Plus a list of resources related to that chapter, including websites and books. An intriguing website, which I emailed to friends, [www.innerworldmedia.com](http://www.innerworldmedia.com) includes a part called 'word magic' where you hold a question in your mind and click on a coloured sphere. A word appears which should in some way be relevant to you. I am a natural sceptic about these types of divinatory tools but asked three different questions relating to my work, relationships and life. I got the same word each time. I later found the probability of getting a word in each sphere is 75:1 and they are randomly assigned to the 8 different spheres each time you visit the site. Work that out if you're any good at maths!

This is the type of book that makes you feel more positive as you read and can be used to dip into or read from cover to cover.
